IF/WHEN.....



THEN....

PARTICIPANTS
MICROPHONES/SOUND
IS NOT MUTED





GIVE A VERBAL REMINDER

SAY "I AM HAVING A HARD TIME HEARING THE DISCUSSION. PLEASE MUTE YOUR MICROPHONES WHEN YOU ARE NOT SPEAKING SO WE CAN HEAR THEM CLEARLY."

YOU ASK A QUESTION AND NO ONE STEPS UP TO START THE DISCUSSION

PEOPLE ARE AFRAID TO OPENLY VOICE THEIR DISAGREEMENT ON AN ISSUE OR DECISION



USE A POLL TO HAVE PARTICIPANTS VOTE



THERE ARE TOO MANY PEOPLE SPEAKING AT THE SAME TIME





ASK PARTICIPANTS TO USE THE "RAISE HAND" FEATURE TO LET YOU KNOW THEY WANT TO SPEAK.

REMIND PARTICIPANTS OF MEETING RULES

IF/WHEN.....



THEN....

NO ONE IS TALKING



CREATE A SLIDE WITH SOME QUESTIONS TO START THE DISCUSSION.

USE A POLL TO GET PEOPLE TO VOTE, YOU CAN THEN DISCUSS THE RESULTS.



ONE PARTICIPANT IS TALKING MORE THAN THE OTHERS



THANK THE PARTICIPANT FOR SHARING THEIR IDEAS.

ASK THE GROUP "WHAT DO YOU THINK OR FEEL ABOUT?"

ONE PARTICIPANT IS
CRITICIZING OR ARGUING WITH
ANOTHER PARTICIPANT





REMIND THE GROUP OF THE RULES.

SPEAK UP AND ASK THE PARTICIPANTS TO STOP ARGUING.

SAY "I FEEL DISSAPOINTED WHEN..."

THEN....

THE DISCUSSION STARTS TO GO OFF TOPIC



THANK THE PARTICIPANTS FOR THEIR INPUT & SUMMARIZE THE RELEVANT IDEAS.

SAY "YOU RAISED SOME INTERESTING, BUT NOT DIRECTLY RELATED IDEAS FOR THIS TOPIC. **CAN WE CONTINUE THIS DISCUSSION AFTER THE MEETING?"**

YOU HAVE TROUBLE HEARING A QUESTION FROM A **PARTICIPANT**



SAY "I'M SORRY, I HAD TROUBLE HEARING WHAT YOU SAID. CAN YOU REPEAT THE QUESTION OR TYPE IT IN THE CHAT BOX?"

ONE PARTICIPANT IS VERY QUIET, NOT SHARING THEIR IDEAS IN THE DISCUSSION



SEND THEM A PRIVATE MESSAGE TO ASK IF THEY ARE OK.

INVITE THEM TO SPEAK, "IS THERE ANYONE ELSE WHO WANTS TO SPEAK THAT HAS **NOT HAD THE OPPORTUNITY?"**
