Key themes and ideas

Families are more than just visitors

Balance safety with need for visits

Gradual re-opening; phased implementation of visits

Visits based on resident needs

Limit visitors: 1/resident at a time

Maintain infection prevention protocols

Train families to wear Personal Protective Equipment

Schedule visits in advance



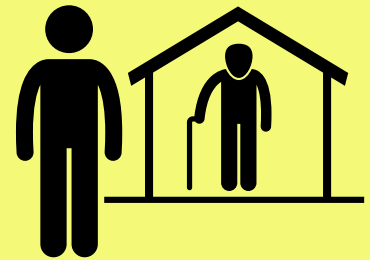
Phased implementation of visits
